Start the planning

Begin your journey with a no obligation wedding consultation at the Bud Hut flower studio where we will chat through your plans. Think details of your bridal party, the venue styling and colour pallet plans; This is to ensure all floral plans both compliment your setting and reflect the dreams you have for your special day. Think fizz, biscuits, confetti samples and indulging in all things flowers for an hour!

Secure your date

After your initial wedding consultation you'll receive a personalised, detailed and itemised vision board & proposal. Your booking form will arrive with the proposal. To secure your date, simply return the completed acceptance form with your deposit payment and you'll be in our diary!

Update your order

Make a note of updates for our final consultation which is usually about two months before the wedding date, we'll be in touch 2 months before to book this in the diary. In the meantime, if you have any questions or need help & advice, simply call or email us. Before our check in we'll always carry out a site visit to your chosen venue to ensure no details are missed in the planning. After this check in your final balance will be due.

Final Planning

Two weeks before the wedding date we'll be back in touch. This is a courtesy call to just to triple check everything. Making sure that all of our plans, logistics and tiny details are all in place. This call is also to make sure that there are no last minute tweaks that need to be made!

The big day

Skip to the morning of the wedding. We'll arrive with our flower army to deliver, set-up and fully style your wedding venue. You'll be drinking champagne and having fun with the bridesmaids and we'll be casting our eye around for each and every perfect flower detail.

The day after

We will return to the venue the following morning to collect any vases or props and pack up any flowers you wish to gift to family & friends.

MAXIMISING YOUR FLORAL BUDGET

GET MORE PETALS FOR YOUR POUND!

Maximizing a wedding flower budget requires some creativity and planning. Here are our top three strategies to get the most out of your floral budget:

1. Prioritise Key Floral Areas

Focus on the areas that will be most visible or meaningful, such as the bridal bouquet, ceremony altar, and reception centrepieces.

2. Reuse & Recycle

Work with your florist to identify designs that can be multi purpose. For example; Think about how you could re-use aisle flowers as table centrepieces for the wedding breakfast.

3. Choose Seasonal Flowers

Seasonal flowers are usually less expensive than out-of-season varieties, as they are easier to source and in abundance. For example Peonies in September will be far more expensive than in May.

FAQ'S

Q. Where are you located & which areas do you cover?

A. We are located in the picturesque countryside village of in Isington, Hampshire. Just 1 mile from Bentley, 5 miles from both Alton & Farnham. We are perfectly located to service all locations across Surrey, Hampshire, Berkshire & West Sussex.

Q. How far in advance do I need to book my wedding flowers?

A. Ideally you should be looking to book your florist 9- 12 months in advance of your wedding date. We do occasionally have last minute availability so it's always worth dropping us a note to check.

Q. Do you offer consultations?

A. Yes! In fact, we recommend them! These are usually done at our flower studio; it's an opportunity for us to discuss all the intricate details of your day, think colour pallets, bridal party numbers and styling ideas – all whilst enjoying a glass of fizz! If you're unable to get to a face-to-face consultation, let us know and we can book in a telephone call!

Q. How do I book in a wedding consultation and is a consultation necessary?

A. You can submit an enquiry form via our website or alternatively you can call or email us to get booked in. Consultations can take place both during weekdays or weekends and in the evening too!

FAQ'S

Q. What should I bring to my consultation?

A. Inspiration! Bring with you screenshots, magazines, photos, or ideas of things that you like (and dislike!). If you have your colour scheme confirmed bring some examples of it with you, your wedding stationary can be a great idea for this. If you don't have any of this just bring your wonderful self – we'll figure it all out together!

Q. What if I don't know what type of flowers I want for my wedding?

A. This is no issue at all! It is our job to guide you through the process, offering tips, ideas and inspiration to help you understand what you like and dislike.

Q. Do you provide other services, like pew ends, rentals, candles for weddings?

A. Absolutely! We can provide hire of items such as arches, candles, candlesticks, and churns. We can discuss this during your consultation as to which items you'd like us to provide for you.

Q. Can you accommodate custom requests?

A. Absolutely; We love them! We're totally here for it if you have a personal touch you'd like to add to your florals, don't be afraid to suggest it!

Q. Do you have a minimum order value?

A. No, we believe beautiful wedding flowers should be accessible to all! Whatever your budget, we'll work with you to create something wonderful!
